- Providing the required application for Wind Turbine Technology admission to the Business & Technology Division Office Coordinator;
- Submitting required documentation for Wind Turbine Technology admission to the Business & Technology Division Office Coordinator, as follows:
  - Application
  - Appropriate letters of recommendation
  - Copy of an original transcript(s) from all college level courses attended
  - Typed, personal statement
  - Proof of current service or discharge from the armed forces
