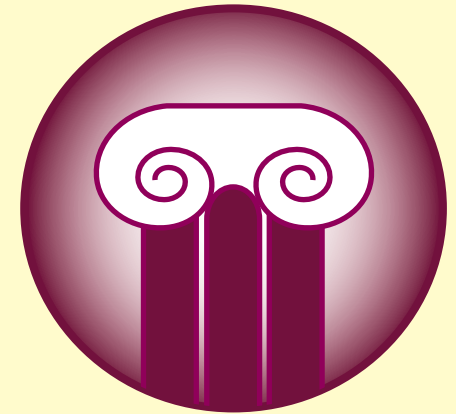
Cost
