

Pell Grant Award Policy – Summer 2010

Beginning with the 2009-2010 academic year students are eligible for up to 2 scheduled awards (200%) per year of Pell grants. For summer 2010 session only: Pell awards will be paid from the 2009-2010 award year (as a trailer). Students interested in receiving federal financial aid for summer 2010 must complete the 2009-2010 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

To receive the First Scheduled Award a student must:

- Be Pell Grant eligible
- Be enrolled at any enrollment status (full-time, $\frac{3}{4}$ time, $\frac{1}{2}$ time or less than $\frac{1}{2}$ time)

To receive the Second Scheduled Award within the same year a student must:

- Continue to be Pell Grant eligible (including SAP status)
- Have received 100% of the First Scheduled Pell Grant Award
- Be enrolled at least $\frac{1}{2}$ time – 3 credits for summer

Pell grants for the summer payment period may be combined using the first and second scheduled awards if the student is eligible.

For students to receive federal aid from HCC they must be degree or certificate seeking at HCC. Students who are enrolled full time at another institution and are coming to HCC only in the summer to take a class or two may be eligible for year round Pell at their home school. HCC will do a consortium agreement with the home school and that school will process the Second Scheduled Award. The student is responsible for payments to HCC per the business office payment policy.
