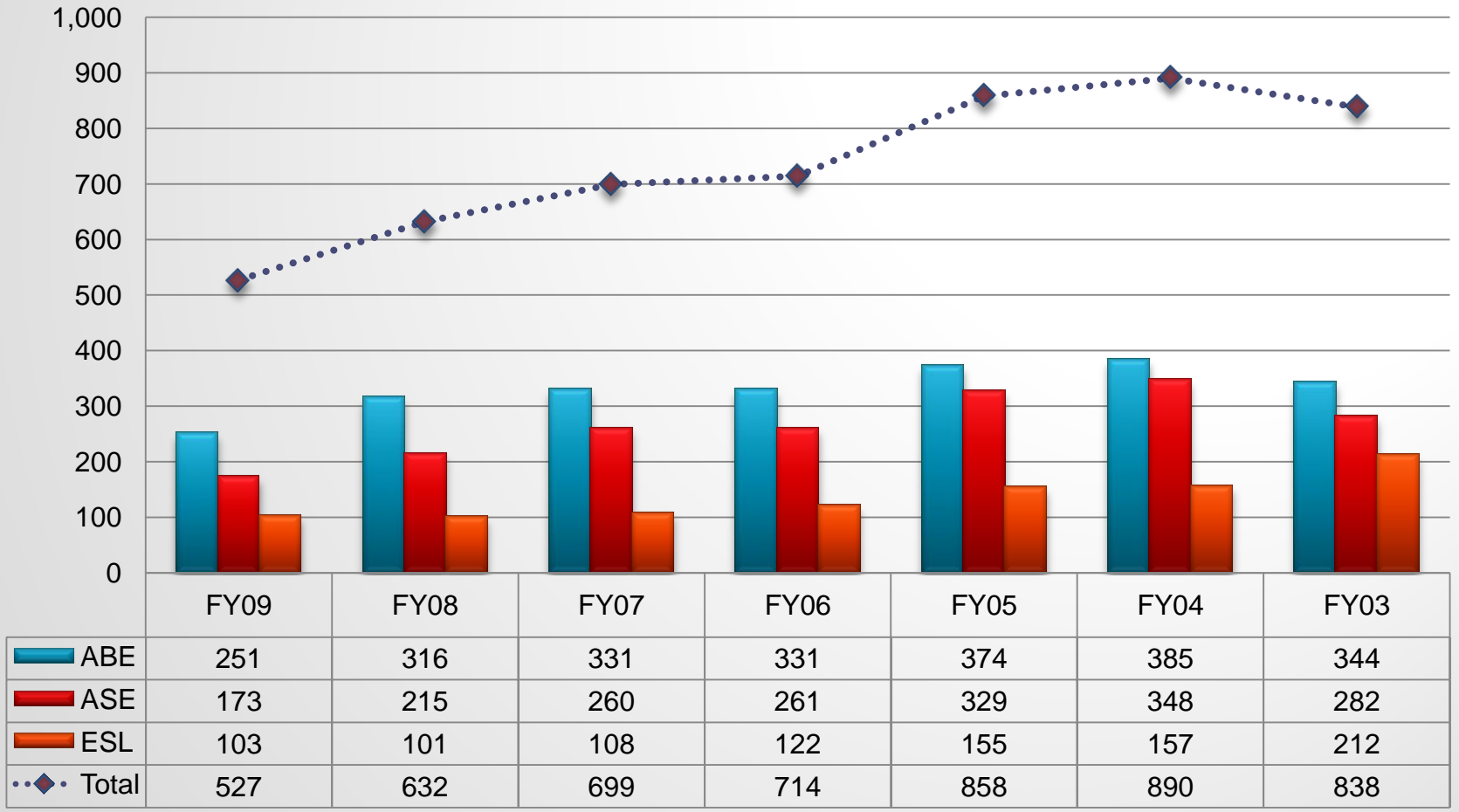

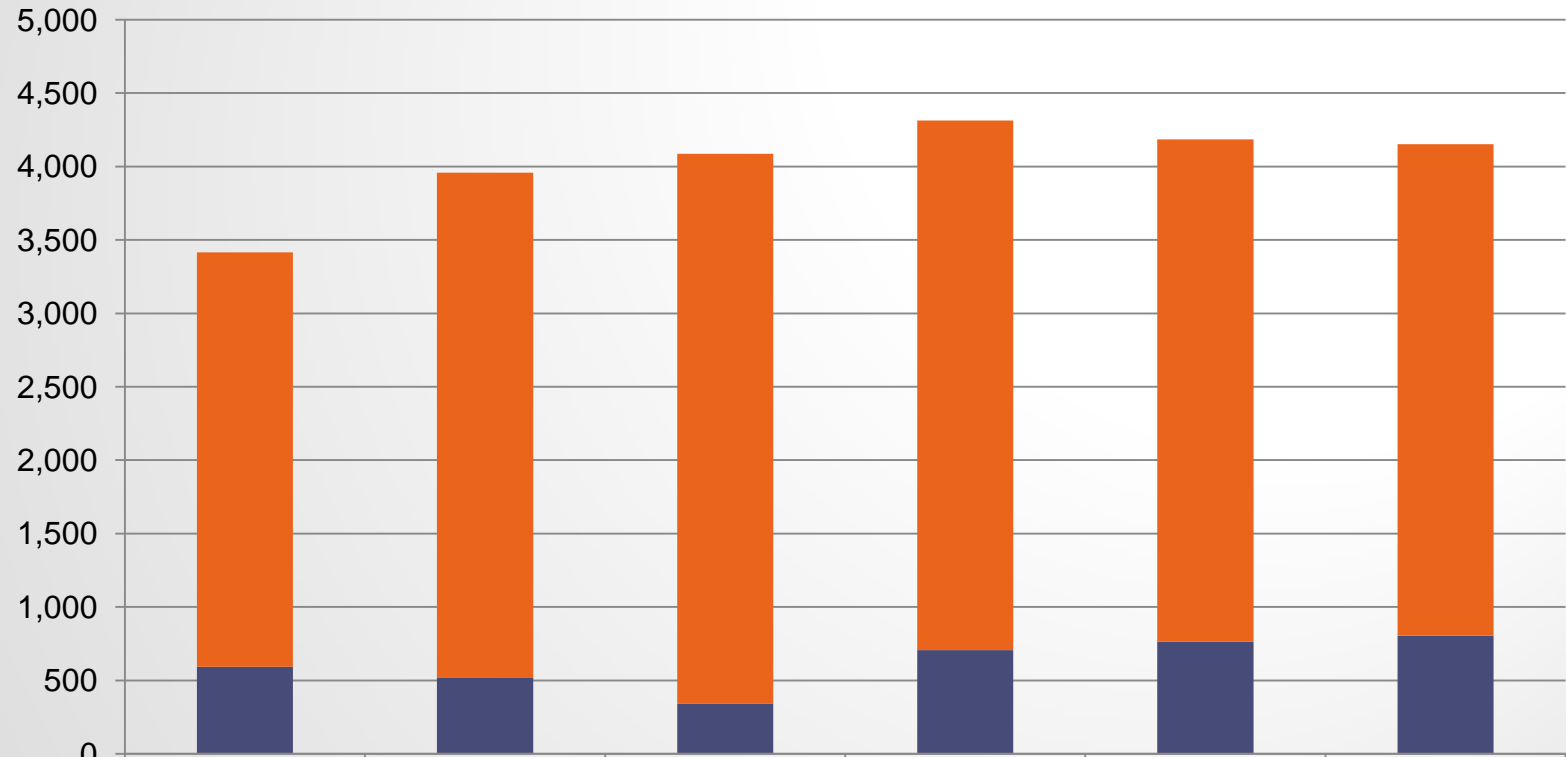

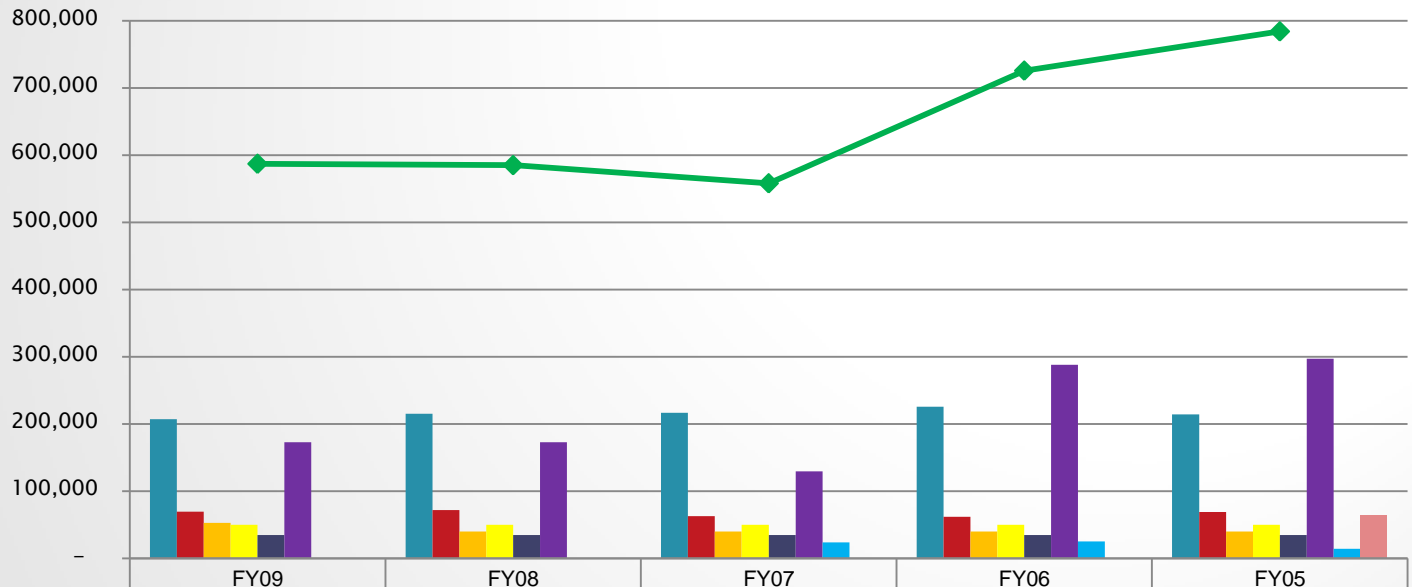

# Adult Education ICCB Credit Hour Reimbursement



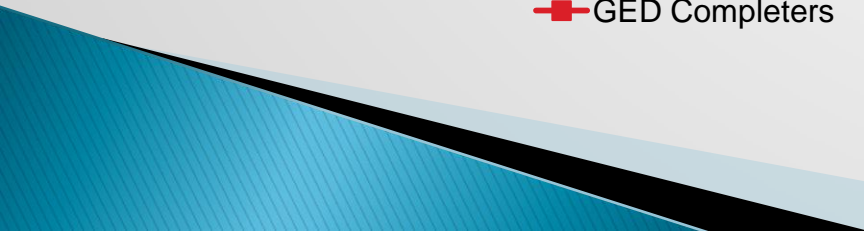
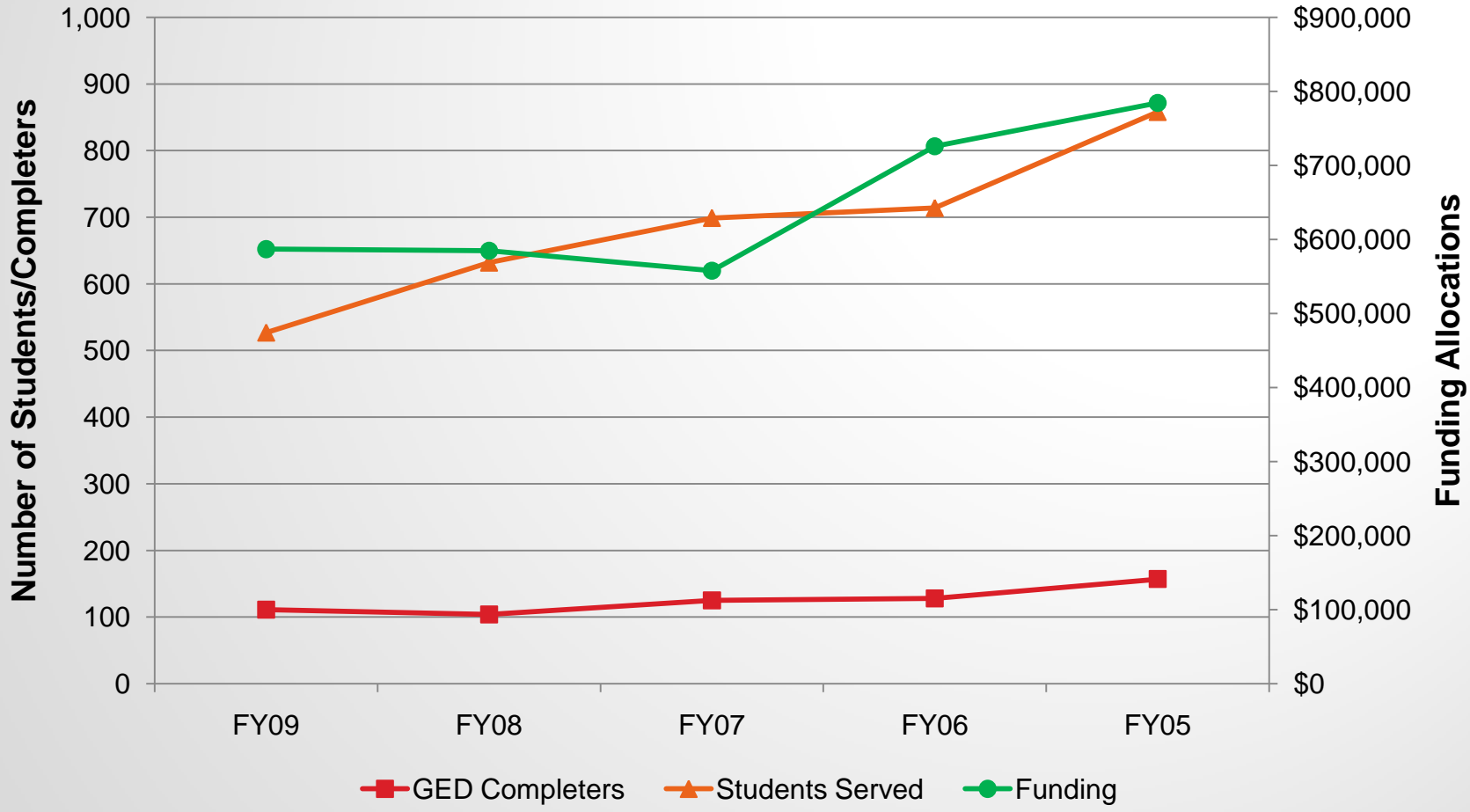
